Course Overview

The LPCAT is a dynamic (test-train-retest) instrument for the measurement of learning potential. It measures the existing fluid reasoning ability level (current performance levels) of the individual as well as projected, presently non-developed, learning potential of the person based on non-verbal figural reasoning.

The Computerised Adaptive Technique has been used, which implies that each individual is tested at the level of his/her performance as the test adapts to the performance level of the individual and selects items of suitable difficulty level to continuously match the estimated ability level of the examinee throughout the test session. It takes approximately one hour to administer – with the pre-test, training and post-test sessions (all computerised) administered in a single administration session. Being a computerised test, the results are immediately available upon completion of the post-test. To eliminate language barriers, it was developed as a non-verbal test and instructions are available in all 11 official SA languages.
